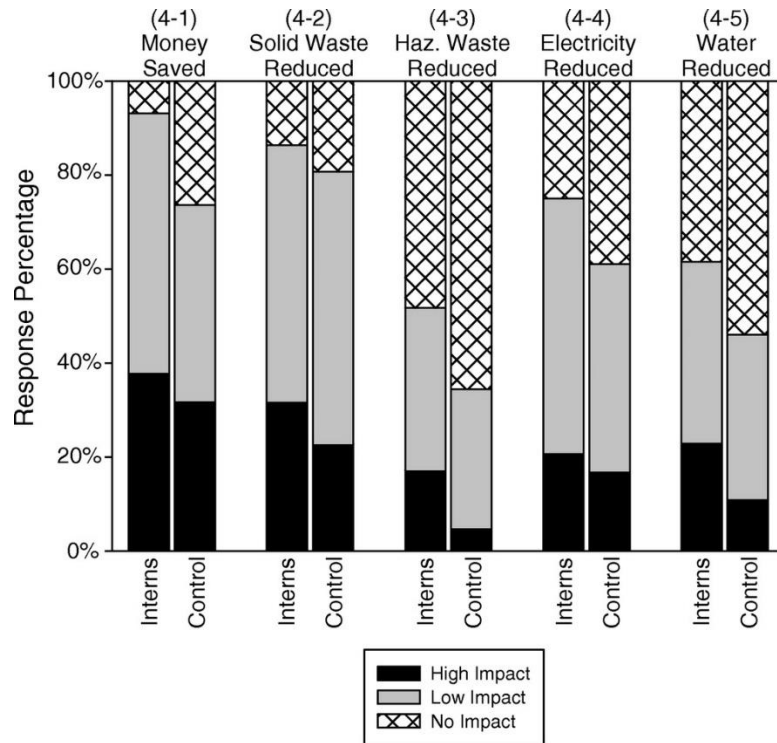


Study Results

- There is a tendency of interns with an intensive sustainability course to more frequently report applying source reduction in the workplace than the control group.
- Interns were about 15% more likely to report implementing source reduction than the control group



- Interns with the intensive sustainability course experience were significantly more likely to report successfully implementing source reduction practices than the control group.
- Interns were able to better quantify the impact of their pollution prevention activities.
