Supporting information should include:

1. Summaries of student evaluations for no more than the last six (6) semesters including written comments. Include departmental averages for comparison purposes.
2. Student letters of recommendation, no more than three (3) from current students and no more than three (3) additional from students who have graduated within the last three (3) years.
3. Scholarly activities related to teaching improvement (e.g. development of new learning experiences, supervision of teaching assistants, work with honors program opportunities, thesis/dissertation committees.
4. Evidence of outstanding service to students in the area of general advising such as advising student clubs and groups, enrollment issues, academic issues, graduate school options, personal counseling related to academic issues.
5. Other relevant evidence such as peer teaching evaluations.
6. Course Listing and Evaluation Form. (Available on the Web site)
7. Written recommendation from the Department Chair.

**Department Chairs should send nomination materials (not exceeding fifteen (15) pages) to the Dean's Office on either campus, attention Becki Barnes by Friday, March 28, 2008, 5:00 P.M.**

**\*\* Only one nominee at assistant rank should be forwarded on.** A person may not be nominated again if he/she has been successful in receiving one of these awards in the last five (5) years.
