### AWARD INFORMATION

The College of Engineering Outstanding Master's Thesis Award is presented annually to a graduate student in the College of Engineering in recognition of original work in the form of a Master's thesis that has made an unusually significant contribution to the discipline. Awards will be made on the basis of both methodological and substantive quality. A selection committee composed of College faculty makes the recommendation of the award recipients to the Dean, based on submitted application materials.

### APPLICATION INFORMATION

- This award is open to graduate students in the UNL College of Engineering who have submitted their Master's thesis for graduation in August 2018, December 2018, or May 2019
- Individuals who have received a Ph.D. (or comparable research degree) in any discipline, prior to writing the Master's thesis are not eligible.
- An individual must be nominated by a faculty member affiliated with the College of Engineering.
- Nomination materials are to be submitted electronically through the on-line submission site, with uploaded documents preferably in PDF format. Please have all materials ready to submit at one time; forms may not be saved and added to at a later time.
- The recipient of this award will receive a certificate and \$500 award, and be honored at the annual College-wide Graduate Student Recognition Event, scheduled for Wednesday, May 1<sup>st</sup> at 3 PM in the Nebraska Unions, Regency Suites.
- The DEADLINE for submitting a complete online nomination form is Monday, March 25, 2019 at 11:59 PM. Late nominations will be accepted.

  - Letter of nomination by the faculty advisor (two-page limit), assessing the significance and quality of the Master's thesis work
  - Letter of support by another member of the dissertation committee (two-page limit), assessing the significance and quality of the Master's thesis work
  - Nominee's curriculum vitae (two-page limit)
  - Abstract of the Master's thesis including its title (not to exceed 10 pages total including graphs/tables/etc.), written by the nominee
