Addendum: College of Engineering Graduate Assistantship Policy

College of Engineering Graduate Assistantship Policy Scenarios

This Addendum clarifies the Policy document that was adopted by the College on 9/1/2021. Specific intent is to clarify statements in Table 1, '21-22 to '23-24 AY M.S. and Ph.D. Assistantship Minimums where Row 2 provides minimum monthly pay amounts for projects being budgeted whose start date would occur the following academic year.

To further clarify Table 1 contents, a series of funding scenarios is provided below. These scenarios focus on funding sources for each fiscal year presented in the table.

Students funded using *internal* sources (includes 21s, 22s, NRI, Tobacco, Research Council, and NU Foundation)

- 1. M.S. or Ph.D. student on Teaching Assistantship
 - a. Paid minimum of \$2300/mo. for '21-22 AY
 - b. Paid minimum of \$2400/mo. for '22-23 AY
 - c. Paid minimum of \$2500/mo. for '23-24 AY
- 2. M.S. or Ph.D. student on Faculty Start-Up
 - a. Paid minimum of \$2300/mo. for '21-22 AY
 - b. Paid minimum of \$2400/mo. for '22-23 AY
 - c. Paid minimum of \$2500/mo. for '23-24 AY
- 3. M.S. or Ph.D. student on Foundation funds that permit funding assistantships
 - a. Paid minimum of \$2300/mo. for '21-22 AY
 - b. Paid minimum of \$2400/mo. for '22-23 AY
 - c. Paid minimum of \$2500/mo. for '23-24 AY

Students funded using *external* sources (WBS designation, except NU Foundation).

NOTES: existing agreements/contracts that specify specific pay rates are *exceptions* to scenarios listed below as contractual obligations must be followed. If existing agreements/contracts budgeted for increases in student pay over life of project those agreements must be followed as well.

- 1. M.S. student completing research (new awards where budgeted student pay matches minimums listed below)
 - a. Paid minimum of \$2300/mo. for '21-22 AY
 - b. Paid minimum of \$2400/mo. for '22-23 AY
 - c. Paid minimum of \$2500/mo. for '23-24 AY
- 2. Ph.D. student completing research (new awards where budgeted student pay matches minimums listed below)
 - a. Paid minimum of \$2300/mo. for '21-22 AY
 - b. Paid minimum of \$2400/mo. for '22-23 AY
 - c. Paid minimum of \$2500/mo. for '23-24 AY

 - d. Paid minimum of \$2600/mo. for '24-25 AYa
