



Partners in Pollution Prevention (P3) Business/Intern Project Agreement

Under this agreement, University will provide Business Client with an intern to work with Business Client on a project defined below, which in turn furthers University’s instructional, research and public service objectives.

A. Scope of Work

Business Client desires to partner with University to provide a pollution prevention internship to a University intern in accordance with the project below (hereinafter referred to as the “Work.”).

To assure mutually beneficial results, at least three fourths of the interns’ time for the period of this Agreement should be spent performing the Work. Other duties relating to the work may be assigned as necessary.

University agrees to use reasonable effort to identify a qualified intern to perform the project described above. Business Client will notify University of any special requirements for interns before University places intern with Business Client. Business Client acknowledges that the University makes no express or implied warranties for results of the Work.

B. Project Supervision

The Business Client will commit to spend dedicated time preparing the intern for their specific pollution prevention project tasks upon initial arrival. Business Client will identify a staff member, hereinafter referred to as the “Project Supervisor” to provide ongoing primary supervision during the Project Period.

D. Period of Performance

The period of performance (“Project Period”) shall be _____ through _____. Work will be conducted during this period and may be extended or terminated by mutual agreement of the parties.

E. Cost and Payment

Business Client shall pay University the amount of _____. Payment in full shall be made to University by Business Client within ten (10) days of completion of the Project Period. An invoice will be provided by University; checks shall be made payable to the University of Nebraska (ID #47-0049123) and mailed to the address noted on the invoice. Business Client shall reimburse the intern for any required travel or operating expenses in conducting his or her projects under Business Client.

F. Intellectual Property

No intellectual property is anticipated out of the Work. Should it be determined at a later date that intellectual property may result from the Work, the parties will negotiate in good faith a mutually acceptable agreement.

G. Permission and Release

Business Client accepts the responsibility to review the intern’s final report and communicate to the University any restrictions regarding business sensitive information for use by the P3 program. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Business Client authorizes the University to use, publish, advertise and/or reproduce the information and photographs produced by the intern in publications or on Web sites developed by University.

H. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Nebraska.
